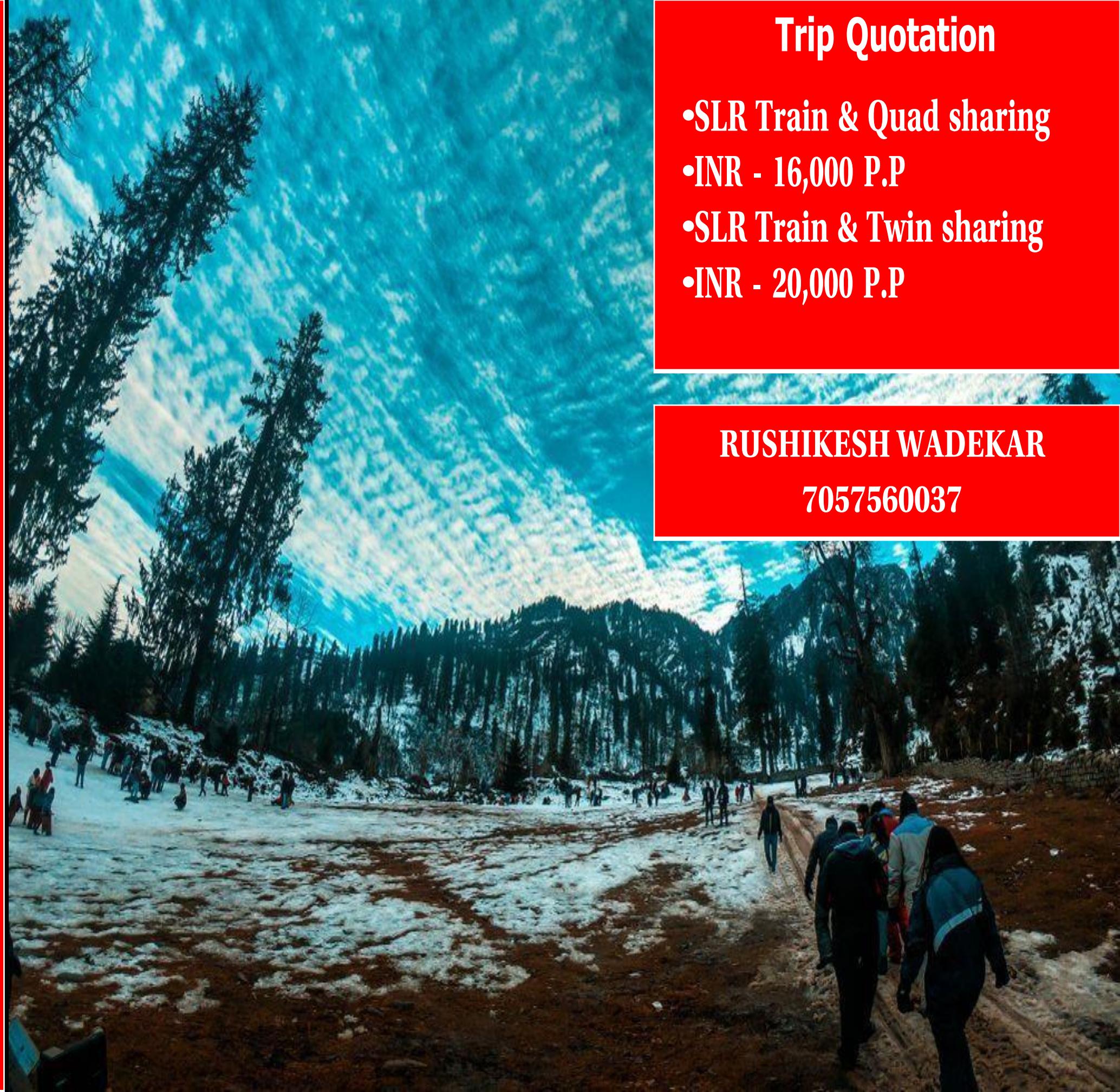

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- In case the tour gets cancelled and transferred to further date due to the ongoing corona pandemic. The booking amount of INR 5000/- is only transferable to further available dates and is non-refundable.
- If an entry wants to cancel its seat 1 month prior the trip 1st instalment will be taken as cancellation fees and the full amount will be charged if cancellation is commenced 15 days prior to date of departure.
- The company is not responsible for additional price on account of some unforeseen events like accidents, breakdown of the vehicle, riot, delay in train etc
- Extra will be charged if government declares any new guideline regarding Hotel stay or transportation. As this tour is designed for rooms in quad sharing.
- The schedule can be changed on the spot by the manager for convenience.
- The company won't be responsible for any unconfirmed train ticket. Confirmation regarding train tickets needs to be made at least 120 days prior.
- On trip manager has full right to dismiss any person from trip if he/she is trying to create a unhealthy environment for others

- Smoking and consumption of alcohol in the bus is strictly prohibited and will be fined INR 500 p.p and company has full right to book that person for breaking no smoking public place rule of Himachal Pradesh Government
- The company won't be responsible in case of any sightseeing gets cancelled due to natural calamities or man-made incidents.
- Indian budget packers will not be responsible for any false or incorrect information submitted to government authorities for any registration/Covid-19
- Report/e-pass etc required as per government guidelines for travel.
- Any discrepancy in travel history shall be the sole responsibility of the customer(s).
- Customer has to submit the photo ID proof all the persons travelling at time of booking.
- Customer(s) are to share complete and correct information for travel detail, failing which, any consequence as per law or any extra charges arising thereof will be borne by the customer only.
- Customer shall bear all liability if he/she is sent to quarantine during travel. Safety is of paramount importance and same is to be adhered to as per government guidelines

- Customer can extend the travel up to 31 March 2021. If due to any government/medical issue customer is not able to travel on the date mentioned in the travel voucher. Same has to be intimated in written e-mail communication along with valid reason and documents as the case maybe.
- Next travel date to be intimated 7 days before the next travel date.
- Indian budget packers reserves the right for travel date extension or refusal for the same as mentioned in the above clause.
- To amend, alter, vary or withdraw any tour, holiday, excursion or facility it has advertised or published or to substitute an Independent Contractor of similar class if it is deemed advisable or necessary. In either case, the Company shall not be liable for any damage, additional expense or consequential loss suffered by the Clients or for any compensation claims made.

GENERAL COVID GUIDANCE

- Each member of the group (participants/leaders/ clients & staff) wears a protective mask while on interaction with each other.
- Do carry few unused, disposable masks.
- It is strongly recommended to wear caps, full sleeves shirts, and full trousers and shoes for adventure activities. It reduces exposure to your body parts.
- It should be ascertained from the participants that they are not residing / have not traveled in a containment zone and have not come in contact with any person who was tested positive in the last 14 days.
- Ascertain whether any participant has any symptoms of Influenza-like illness (ILI) like fever, dry cough, weakness, severe body ache, etc. at the time of the beginning of the activity. If it is so then he/she should be asked not to participate actively and be evacuated on medical grounds and should be asked to report to the local health authorities with his own expenses.
- Maintain a distance of 6 feet when you sleep in the night. If for some reason such distancing is not possible, then try sleeping in a criss-cross manner to avoid face proximity.

- Do carry plastic sheets as ground-sheet. (Remember to bring them back!)
- Strictly avoid eating gutkha, pan masala, cigarette, or sniffing tapir which induces spitting, coughing, or sneezing.
- Avoid touching external surfaces and touching your face when outdoors. If the location of your adventure activity is too crowded then be prepared to leave or wait for the crowd to disperse/for your turn.
- It is mandatory that a participant informs the organizers if he tests positive for COVID within 14 days of returning from adventure activity. It will help the organizers to inform and alert all other persons in the group so that they can follow the medical/government norms in this regard.
- Here it is absolutely essential that the participant observes transparency and informs the organizers/group leaders about his COVID test results.
